iii. Writing a Business letter in 120-150 words. One out of the two given questions to be answered. **(5 marks)**

iv. Writing a Debate in 120-150 words. One out of the two given questions to be answered. **(5 Marks)**

i. Reference to the context : one poetry extract (out of 2) from Hornbill **(3x1 marks)**

iii. One Prose extract out of two from the book **Snapshots** **(4x1=4 Marks)**

VII. Two Short answer type question (one from Prose and one from Poetry from the book Hornbill),- out of four, to be answered in 40-50 words. **(3x2=6 Marks)**

VIII. One Short answer type question, from the book Snapshots, to be answered in 40- 50 words. Any 1 out of 2 questions to be done. **(3x1=3 Marks)**

IX. One Long answer type question, from Prose/Poetry Hornbill, to be answered in 120-150 words- Any 1 out of 2 questions to be done. **(1x6=6 Marks)**

X. One Long answer type question, based on the chapters from the book **Snapshots** to be answered in 120-150 words Any 1 out of 2 questions to be done. **(1x6=6 Mark)**
